MRP Handbook: Met with EMHSD and will preload the following MRPs into MASS: Engine Strike Team, Fire Task Force, Crew Transport, USAR Type III with and without Swiftwater, Swiftwater Type 1, 2 and 3, Structures Specialist, Medical Support, Search Team, Canine - Human Remains (Needs to be developed).

We will follow the same process as an intra-state request, 1) identify available resource who can accept the mission 2) EMHSD will send the estimated MRP 3) providing agency will update MRP with personnel, travel and mission days 4) if MRP is accepted, then EMHSD will update MRP to execute a RSA to authorize deployment.

**ERG Distribution:** Here is the link to the Google Sheet for the distribution status. There are only a few on the list with no plan or no communications with me. A few are receiving their books at the Homeland Security Conference as referenced by HLSC and one at the MI Chiefs Conference. Detroit was not on the order and not part of Wayne County's order but they called and were given 40 boxes. Shadd is likely taking at least one pallet (36 Boxes) to the HLSC and we will still have at least 2 full pallets at the MOB to distribute (get rid of).

MABAS Online Training: Working on two different free version of virtual learning platforms; will send a link for leadership to review as soon as they are up;

UAS Sarcop Interface: SARCOP - Updating policies and procedures as a data collection tool; Map Builder, Arc GIS within ESRI will be used for map building and creating search sectors; Working with Shannon from MSP on further develop of SARCOP.

MI-TF1 Training: ORE (May 13-16) is the main focus; GPS Land Navigation course was attended by 30 members from various divisions and look to hold an additional class in 2025; Holly exercise at the KRC building is June 8 with Midland and one other team committed; Tiawanese delegation exercise in Grayling on July 9-10; Preparing for small ORE, possibly training with MI-ANG, MSP Spec Ops and Tiwainese on July 9-10.

MRP Team Leaders: Leadership team met to continue updating the MRP Resource Guide. Shaun Patterson is working on the MRP Checklists for each MRP that will guide the MRP Support team members on prepping and loading the needed equipment for deployment.

The spreadsheets for the three MRPs that have been loaded into MASS have been sent to Matt Cook. 8 additional MRPs have been identified to be uploaded into MASS to show Michigan's available MRPs to EMAC. These will include MABAS Engine ST, Fire TF and Crew Transport Strike Teams. These will be finalized and loaded over the next few weeks. Need to work with Pat Parker on the MABAS MRPs.

Deployment Coordinators: Assisted DFD during the NFL Draft. Detroit was well organized for the event but they needed radios that Shadd arranged to be brought to the command post on day 1. There were no incidents that required MABAS assistance. DFD leadership expressed their appreciation for our assistance and willingness to to help if needed.

MI-TF1 Plans Team Managers: Continue to prep for the ORE including finalizing team objectives and MESL injects. Two have been identified: The Patriot Golf Course is the primary site (south of Grayling), and Hartwick Pines main office and maintenance buildings area is the backup site. They have some restrictions that would need to be addressed.
