MI-TF1: Admin Days for 160 members, most we have ever had!! Updating agency contacts and hourly rates for MRPs. Established Section Meeting Agendas for each Section to document Personnel, Equipment and PPG. Assigned TFL will report out. Setting training dates for MI-TF1 MRP Team Leaders and Support Staff.

We are transitioning to a Program Manager shared email and importing into Google Shared Drive in baby steps. There are some challenges we are working through.

Budget Update: FY23 year end report was accepted by LARA (post on website). FY24 first installment of \$500k has been received.

Senator Klinefelt indicated that the state budget process starts with the Appropriations Sub Committee Chair, who proposes to Approps Committee. Approps Chair and Governor have final negotiation. LARA Chair is Senator Mary Cavanaugh-D from District 6 (Farmington, Redford Twp and parts of Livonia, Farmington Hills and Detroit). We need to invite her to MOB.

Reimbursement: Waiting for Vermont reimbursement. VT SAR Coordinator Mike Gannon forward our packet to EMAC A-Team for reimbursement. Created FD specific fringe benefit instructions to replace EMD-055. Sent to each Sponsoring Chief and Admin yesterday with a 12/9 deadline.

MRP's: Attended the SUSAR workshop and meeting with Matt Cooke on 12/5. We should be uploading our MRPs with approximate cost into the MASS System. MI EMAC Coordinator can upload from MASS into EMAC Operating System. The requesting state can approve from the estimate and the final Travel, Equipment and Personnel roster are completed for the Req-A which is the final approval. Hopefully EMHSD approves the process and we can upload into MASS. This will save us the leg work upfront before we know if we will be deployed. Need to establish list of MRPs with personnel, equipment and vehicles.

MI-TF1 Type III USAR with and without water are complete as is Swiftwater Type I and II.
