- 2. How would this account connect HVA dispatch or Eaton dispatch to be able to access the notification templates and send out messages? Each agency's employees would have to be added to the account for access to the templates. Eaton does not use Everbridge so they would all have to have a login. Could we use just 2 or 3 standard logins and not complicate it? Yes.
- 3. Can the current Washtenaw account give a few MABAS members admin rights to handle difficulties at 3 am during an incident? He did not have an answer and would have to research it.
