Description:	<p>This two-day training program is designed to better align the efforts of our first responders during vehicle entrapment incidents. Day One provides first responders with a better understanding of the tools and techniques available for the proper extrication of victims from vehicle entrapments. Day Two is scheduled for outdoors and includes actual hands-on experience with extrication tools.</p> <p>Firefighter PPE gear is required, including safety glasses and gloves.</p>
