Presenter: The training is a collaboration between MMRMA and Oakland Community College.

The course will be taught by State certified instructors utilizing multiple methods of

instruction.

Description: This two-day training program is designed to better align the efforts of our first

responders during vehicle entrapment incidents. Day One provides first responders with a better understanding of the tools and techniques available for the proper extrication of victims from vehicle entrapments. Day Two is scheduled for outdoors and includes

actual hands-on experience with extrication tools.

Firefighter PPE gear is required, including safety glasses and gloves.

Training Objectives: After the completion of the two-days of training, the attendee will be able to:

• Broaden their extrication skillsets.

• Emphasize gaining entry, freeing, and removing trapped individual(s).

• Underscore the importance of not causing further harm to the individual(s) trapped.
