standards of operating small Unmanned Aircraft Systems (sUAS) in the public domain during fires, search & rescue operations, investigations, infrastructure

inspections, and training. Once the student has completed the pre-class

assignments and the two-day course, attendees may challenge the FAA's Part 107

test to safely fly sUAS in National Airspace.

**Training Objectives:** Upon course completion, the attendee will be able to:

• Understand Part 107 of the FAA's remote pilot program

• Demonstrate a working knowledge of drones (sUAS)

• Demonstrate how to safely fly drones (sUAS)

• Understand national airspace limitations

• Assist in the development of sUAS guidelines for your organization, etc.
