

Rescue Task Force (RTF) Training

Description: This two-day training program for **Fire/EMS personnel** is designed to better align the efforts of our **Fire/EMS personnel** with our law enforcement officers who are first responders to active assailant incidents and includes the concepts of Tactical Casualty Care (TCC). Up to 11 CE's for MFR, EMT, and Paramedic (includes required Emergency Preparedness credits). Class numbers are limited per department and sessions fill up fast.

Training Objectives: Upon course completion, attendees will be able to -

- Conduct rapid patient assessment and perform emergency medical interventions
- Demonstrate proficiency with the application of tourniquets, hemostatic agents, and pressure bandages
- Apply occlusive dressings to penetrating chest wounds and control a patient's airway, etc.

- Develop deployment options as a rescue group and/or with tactical law enforcement

Presenter: Tactical Encounters, Inc. is a Michigan-based training group that trains extensively in reality-based scenarios. Tactical Encounters, offers training in the latest best practices for responding to active assailant incidents tactically and efficiently.
